**(Omaha, NE, March 23, 2011)** Since 2001, the Willis Fellow has recognized exceptional leadership programs and initiatives of Fraternity Executives Association (FEA) members and their respective organizations. During the past 10 years, nearly 90 programs have been nominated and 20 individuals and organizations have been recognized for excellence in educational initiatives as Fellows or as runners-up for the award.

Regrettably, the Willis Fellow is being discontinued. The Fellow was initiated in partnership with and at the request of the Fraternity Executives Association in 2001, and enjoyed a productive partnership for ten years.
